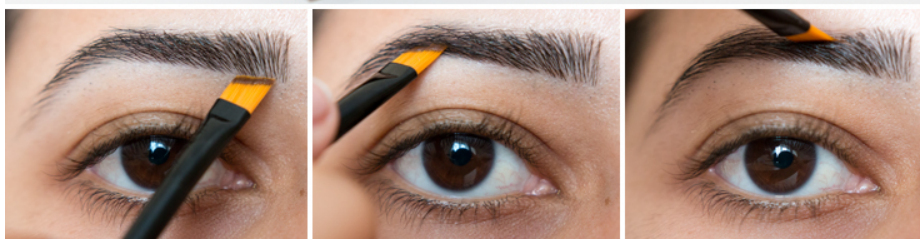


FILL IN YOUR EYEBROWS

with BENEFIT BROW ZINGS

the easy way!



STEP 1

Dip the angled brush into your soft, pigmented wax. With smooth, angled strokes, shape & define brows.



STEP 2

Use the blending brush to apply your setting powder. This powder fills in sparse areas and locks brows in place.



I reviewed the [Benefit Brow Zings Brow Shaping Kit](#) a million years ago (*not quite - more like 3 years ago*), but I've never really done a **tutorial on how to use it to fill in eyebrows**. I know the whole thing is pretty self-explanatory, but if you're new to the eyebrow-filling party or just not really sure where to start, *maybe a picture-tutorial will be helpful!*

The entire process is super quick (*under 2 minutes for me!*) and Benefit really does make it easy by giving you all the tools you need in one neat little compact kit - *angled brush, blending brush & mini tweezers*. The palette is available in *Light, Medium and Deep* - **the one I used is Medium**, and as you can see from the pictures, it looks pretty good on my super dark eyebrows! I also own the Deep kit, but I think I can get a much softer look with the Medium one.
